

From the Bible we can easily identify which day is God's 7th day Sabbath. Here is one way: (Read carefully)

KJV Luke 23:52 –Luke 24:3 (Find it in your Bible!)

Luke 23:52 This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. 53 And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid. 54 And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on. 55 And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid. 56 And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment. Luke 24:1 Now upon the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain others with them. 2 And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre. 3 And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus.

This passage of Scripture clearly identifies the Sabbath as the day between “the preparation day” (which is Friday, the day Jesus died) – and “the first day of the week” (which the world knows as Sunday).

The world celebrates the death of Jesus as "Good Friday"!! It also celebrates the day He arose from the dead as “Easter Sunday”...But the day between, Saturday / the Sabbath (the day the women kept) - the majority of the world forget or reject!

Isn't that interesting?

It is even more interesting that the 4th Commandment of the 10 Commandments starts with "**Remember** the Sabbath day..."!!
(Read Exodus 20:8 -11)

IF WE DON'T KNOW WHICH DAY IS THE SABBATH GOD WINKS AT IT, BUT WHEN WE KNOW WE MUST REPENT:

KJV **Acts 17:30** And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: 31 Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

IF WE REJECT THE TRUTH OF GOD'S WORD WE WILL END UP BELIEVING A LIE AND END UP BEING DAMNED.

KJV **2 Thessalonians 2:9 – 12.** 9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12 That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

SO WE ALL MUST MAKE A CHOICE TO OBEY GOD OR NOT.

KJV **Joshua 24:15** And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

KJV John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

(Read verses 1 – 14)

KJV **John 3:16 – 19.** 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

NOW, TODAY, IF WE HEAR GOD'S VOICE WE MUST ACCEPT...WE MUST NOT HARDEN OUR HEARTS.

KJV **Hebrews 4:7** Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts. **(Read also Hebrews 3 verses 8 and 15)**
