

What does the Major Denominations say about the change from Sabbath to Sunday?




1. The Lutherans




Eight verses mention the First Day of the Week (Sunday) none sanctions worshiping / observing the day as a Sabbath,


- Search the scripture in vain for authority on the change from seventh day to first day, you will never find it.

8. Seventh-day Adventist




 Believes in all the precepts of Christ found in both New and Old Testament, **Obeys the Ten** Commandments, as it reflects the character of God, including the fourth, which says:






